A Private Bahamian Island Lists for \$22 Million

A private island in the Bahamas has listed for \$22 million. The sellers Harrington, Miami-based brothers who are former investment bankers

The island, which includes a 4,000-square-foot-house, has two miles of land. It's about five minutes by boat from the island of Great Exuma international airport and luxury resorts. Celebrities like David Copperfield and Faith Hill own islands nearby.
